



NEBOSH National General Certificate in Occupational Health and Safety

Health and safety is a fundamental aspect of a manager's role in today's working environment. NEBOSH National General Certificate is a ten-day course (plus 2 days for examinations and revision) designed for supervisors, managers, employee representatives and others who may have responsibility for health and safety at work, providing them with the knowledge to carry out their jobs more effectively and to ensure that decisions are based on a wide range of health and safety knowledge.

Certification
