Course Content

Module 1 – Introduction and overview

Why employers have a responsibility for providing a safe working environment from a moral, economic and legal point of view.

Module 2 – Risk assessment

How to carry out a risk assessment and implement control measures, looking at accident prevention and occupational ill health. Delegates will carry out a risk assessment exercise.

Module 3 – Risk control

How to control risk and take a practicable approach to risk assessment.

Module 4 – Health and safety legislation

Looking at safety legislation, how it affects decisions in the work place and how our legal system works.

Module 5 – Common hazards

Identifying common hazards in the work place.

Module 6 – Investigating accidents and incidents

Identifying why accidents happen and how they should be investigated.

Module 7 – Measuring performance

Preparing basic performance indicators for monitoring and safety improvement.

Module 8 – Environment protection

Identify the basic requirements for the control of waste and pollution, its impact on employee safety and the wider community.
